

Your gift could be worth 25% more to us at no extra cost to you.

- That's right, your kind gift can be worth 25% more with a Gift Aid Declaration. And if you are a 40% or higher taxpayer you can reduce the amount of tax you pay next time you complete a self-assessment tax return or ask HM revenue and customs to adjust your tax code (you will need receipts for your gifts to make your claim).
- Nearly everyone is eligible, if you pay enough UK Income Tax and /or Capital Gains tax you qualify. Under the scheme, we can claim 25p in every £1 from HMRC on all donations made in the past four years, and in the future

 whatever rate of tax you pay.
- It really couldn't be easier, we don't even need your signature. There is no ongoing commitment you can cancel your Gift Aid Declaration at any time by simply dropping us a line or calling us here at the office.

Just follow these simple steps – to Gift Aid your donations – it won't cost you a penny!
