Syon House is the London home of the Duke and Duchess of Northumberland and has been for over 400 years, the last surviving ducal residence complete with its country estate in Greater London. It is a wonderful home, steeped in history, with fantastic paintings and furniture, and perhaps the finest Robert Adam interior in the country. Over the years, members of the Royal Family and numerous heads of state have been entertained in the private dining room and drawing room, surrounded by family portraits by artists including Gainsborough, Gilbert Stuart and Reynolds.

The tour will take approximately one to one and a half hours and will be led by Lady Julia Craig Harvey, sister of the current Duke of Northumberland, who grew up at Syon House and Alnwick Castle, the family home in Northumberland. It will include parts of the house not normally open to the public.
