ABOUT 12for12

What is 12for12?

12for12 is a virtual run in aid of Children with Cancer UK. We're asking people to join our #12for12 club by running 12k on World Cancer Day (4th Feb 2020) to support the 12 children diagnosed with cancer in the UK every day.

How do I sign up?

To register please visit www.12for12.co.uk

How much does it cost to sign up?

Registration costs just £12

When does registration close?

Registration for 12for12 closes at 1pm on Monday 3rd February.

What will the money go towards?

Your donation will go towards vital research to save the lives of children with cancer and keep their families together. We also fund various services that support families during treatment and beyond such as accommodation near to hospitals, financial hardship grants and fun family days out.

What do I get for signing up?

You will receive a pair of limited-edition gold branded shoelaces and a free ticket (worth £10) to the National Running Show at Birmingham's NEC on 25th & 26th January 2020.

Please note the final date to sign up for 12for12 and receive a pair of shoe laces is Sunday 26th January at 7pm. You can still register to join the club after this date but we are no longer able to send you shoe laces.

I heard that people at the National Running Show were able to buy a medal for £3. Can I have one?!

Yes! We are delighted to offer members of the 12for12 club the chance to purchase a medal as a momentum of your challenge. They cost £4.50 (which equates to £3 for the medal and £1.50 for post and packing). If you would like to purchase one please telephone Children with Cancer UK on 0207 404 0808. The medal will be posted to you after World Cancer Day (Tuesday 4th February)

I heard that Susie Chan is leading a Children with Cancer UK 12for12 run on World Cancer Day (Tuesday 4th Feb). Can I join?

Yes! We would love for any members of the 12for12 club to join us at this run. It will take place at 1pm on Tuesday 4th Feb at Regent's Park (exact location TBC). Changing room facilities will be available. If you would like to join us please either click the tick box to express your interest in this run during the registration process when you are signing up for 12for12 OR if you have already registered before this option was available, please email us on 12for12@childrenwithcancer.org.uk to express your interest so we can provide you with the full details.

Do I need to register for the 12for12 Club to take part in the run with Susie Chan?

Yes please. We will be checking names on the day so please make sure you register at 12for12.co.uk (ticking the box to express your interest in the Regent's Park run) OR if you have already registered before the run was announced email us on 12for12@childrenwithcancer.org.uk to let us know that you would like to join us so we can send you the details.

Who is Susie Chan?

Susie Chan is an Endurance Runner, who takes on races of all distance from 1 mile to 100 miles. She has run the Marathon des Sables more times than any other UK female. Named "the number 1 runner to follow on Instagram" by Runners World, she has a huge influence in the running world. She is also a cancer survivor, understanding the challenges faced by patients and how to use running as a positive focus through treatment.

I'd like to do my own 12for12 but I don't want to run. Can I still take part?

Yes of course, you don't have to run. Please feel free to run, jog or walk. You can do your challenge anywhere from your local gym to your favourite park.

Do I have to do it on World Cancer Day?

No, please feel free to do your run any time that week that suits you (ideally up until Sunday 9th February)

When will I get my laces?

You will receive your shoelaces in the post before World Cancer Day (Tuesday 4th Feb 2020). ***Please note the final date to sign up for 12for12 and receive a pair of shoe laces is Sunday 26th January at 7pm. You can still register to join the club after this date but we are no longer able to send you shoe laces.***

Do I have to wear the laces?

No, you don't have to wear the laces if you don't want to.

Can I / Do I have to fundraise as part of my challenge?

We are very grateful to everyone who signs up to do the 12for12 challenge and are not expecting you to fundraise but if you would like to, why not set up a Facebook fundraiser? Facebook gives you the opportunity to share your fundraising activity with your friends. To create a Facebook fundraiser:

2. Enter how much money you would like to raise and the end date of the fundraiser
3. Give your fundraiser a title and describe the reason why you're raising money 4. Choose a photo for your fundraiser and click "Create"
