



Children with Cancer UK Terms & Conditions

Altra Yorkshire Marathon 2026 – Own Place

Please note that you must have secured your own place in the 2026 Altra Yorkshire Marathon event taking place on Sunday 18 October 2026, independently of the charity.

Registration

1. To join the Children with Cancer UK team, you need to provide confirmation that you have secured your own place, independently of the charity. This should be your official confirmation letter or email from the organisers, with your name on it.
2. Should you, for whatever reason, not take your place, all sponsorship forms and monies collected should be forwarded to Children with Cancer UK or returned to your sponsors.

Health and Safety

1. You confirm that you are medically fit and that you participate in the event at your own risk. Children with Cancer UK will not be held responsible for injury or illness resulting from your participation in the event.
2. You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by the race organisers and to comply with these.
3. The minimum age for this event is 18 years old. You confirm you will be the minimum age on race day (Sunday 18 October 2026).
4. As the event is external to Children with Cancer UK, Children with Cancer UK shall not be liable for any loss or damage that participants suffer because of taking part in the event.

Data Protection and Privacy

1. You have provided Children with Cancer UK information about you and consent to Children with Cancer UK using this data. You understand that it will be



necessary for Children with Cancer UK to share the data with the race organiser for you to participate in this event.

2. We do not sell or swap your details with any third parties, but to carry out our work we may need to pass your details to service companies authorised to act on our behalf. For further information, please see our privacy policy:

3. We will keep your details on our database so we can provide you with the best possible support every time you contact us.

All participants, supporters and spectators, including friends and families who choose to attend the event confirm that they are happy for their names, video footage, photographs taken of them during the event to be used to publicise the event by Children with Cancer UK for commercial and fundraising purposes including, but not limited to marketing material, television broadcasts, social media, advertising, publications, and other documents or mediums that may be made available to the public.
 - a. Photographs of children will not be used in this manner without express written consent, unless the images are incidental.

Miscellaneous

1. You acknowledge that Children with Cancer UK may incur costs because of you joining the Children with Cancer UK team (e.g. cost of producing and sending fundraising pack/technical kit) for this event.
2. All participants understand that any products distributed at the event are subject to availability and may be withdrawn or substituted if necessary.
